INTRODUCTION

The National service Scheme (NSS) unit of Panigaon OPD College was started with the objective of developing students' personality through community service. Every year the NSS unit of Panigaon OPD college is conducting special camp programme in the adopted village. For NSS Special Camp of the academic year 2022-23, 3 No. Na- ali kaibarta village, Lakhimpur District was selected, after analysing the village physical environment, basic civic amenities and the social conditions of the village. A fact-finding mission was conducted before the camp by the program officer, faculties and volunteers under the guidance of Dr. Suresh Dutta, Principal, Panigaon OPD College and Mr. Joyprakash Bhuyan, Program Officer, NSS unit. The fact-finding team had discussions with the village officials, school head masters and the volunteer group of the adopted village and finalized the community service program in the village.

The special Camp program was scheduled between 25th of May to 31th of May 2022(7 days). Prior Permission was obtained from the Panchayat Board, Block Development Office and local Police Station. The Special Camp was planned with the main purpose of creating awareness among the village people for a better living and transforming the village a model village.

Tree Plantation And Inaugural Program

Health Check-Up Camp



The day started with Morning assembly and prayer followed by the attendance of the NSS volunteers. On this day a one day free medical camp organized for the benefit of public in 3 no. Na- Ali Kaibarta village on 26th May, 2022. The Medical Camp was conducted at Na -ali village Health Center . The organizing team including 25 NSS Volunteers led by Mr. Jibedhar Nath, Assistant Professor, Department of

Economics, Panigaon OPD College. The Medical team consisted of two rural doctors from Panigaon Medical Center. A total 98 number of villagers attend the medical camp and benefitted. The NSS unit also arranged for free blood sugar level and Blood pressure tests which were hugely useful for many villagers. After completion of check-up Medicines provided with free of cost by NSS unit, Panigaon OPD College. The NSS volunteers played a vital role in making this day successful one.

NSS CAMP DAY-III (27/5/2022)

AIDS Awareness camp

The day started with Morning assembly and prayer followed by the attendance of the NSS volunteers. Then the volunteers undertook cleaning and exercise session. On this day an awareness program on AIDS was conducted under NSS unit, Panigaon OPD College at primary school campus of our adopted village, 1no. Na- ali Kaibarta. 


NSS CAMP DAY-IV (27/5/2022)

A Socio- Economic Survey in Adopted village

The NSS unit of Panigaon OPD College organized a Socio-Economic survey on 28th May 2022 at adopted village, 3 no. Na- ali kaibarta. 40 Student volunteers were involved in this activity under the supervision of Programme officer Mr. J.P Bhuyan (Associated Professor & HOD, Department of History), Mr. J. Nath (HOD, Department of Economics), Mr. J. Engti (Department of Economics) and Mr. A. Nath (Department of History).

The main motive of this survey camp is to collect data on availability of various infrastructure facilities like education, health monitoring, economic status and facilities for economic weaker person in the selected villages. After the survey the NSS volunteers came to know about the latest situation of the village households. This helps the student volunteers to increase their
