Concept Note

The notion of citizenship has been a contested issue in mainstream discourses, spanning from political rallies to media channels discussions, dwelling on themes tied closely with the state of our nation. The Constitution of India recognized citizenship within a legal status; having a nationality and being member of the nation-state and deriving rights and entitlement guaranteed by the Constitution. For academicians the notion of citizenship has been stressed within the ambit of a territorial circumscribed nation-state while many jurist and legal thinkers today tend to see citizenship beyond legal framework - and therein lies the need for an understanding, a dialogue across broad spectrum of intelligentsia.

There has been long discussion about whether citizenship necessarily involves a relationship amid individuals and a state or other territorial entity and about whether it is connected just with the "public" and more specifically the "political" sphere, i.e., whether or not the formulation of citizenship should guarantee a minimum level of welfare. In many cases, separation of borders and boundaries have shaped the idea of citizenship, this makes the notion of citizenship challenging when the history of the frontiers and state is ignored. In this context, there is a strong view that citizenship needs to go beyond the legal or formal status of belonging within confined territory.

In many cases, the practice of citizenship instead of inclusionary, it is exclusionary leaving some section of the group marginalized, which can be seen resulting in the form of cultural politics. There has also been conflict and ethnic tensions over granting of citizenship in tribal areas to other communities within inter-intra state, illegal migrants and internally displaced people.

In recent times the Indian State reviewed numerous provisions of citizenship and adopted the Amended Act in 2019. Keeping several paradigms of citizenship inclusively, this seminar is aimed to highpoint the theme "DISCOURSES IN CITIZENSHIP AND IDENTITY: PERCEPTION & REALITY" with the following sub themes that are not exhaustive.

SUBTHEMES

1. National Register of Citizens' Legal Framework and Implementation.
2. Issues regarding D-Voters.
3. Citizenship Laws in India and Political Rhetoric.
4. Citizenship Laws in India and Constitutional Morality.
5. Post-NRC Regime & Citizenship Amendment Act 2019 - Provisions of the Act and their impartial analysis.
6. Issues regarding Illegal Migrants and Detention Camps.
7. Citizenship Identity in context of Migration, Internally Displaced Persons and Refugees in North-East Indian States.
8. Gender issues in Citizenship debates.
9. Citizenship and religion.
10. Any other issues related to the seminar topic.
